Please ask an adult, or older brother or sister to check your answers.

Reading

1. Find an object in your house that starts with these sounds: t, i, n, c
2. Spread some flour (or any other substance that you can write in) on a baking sheet and write these vocabulary words: I, to, and, go, you
3. Find something in your house that rhymes with: stable, fish, blue
4. Blend and read these words: not, cap, did
5. Choose a decode book to read to someone. Don't forget to touch under each word as you read it. Then tell them what the story was about.

Math

1. Count out 15 objects (Any object will do - pennies, buttons, legos, raisins, race cars, cereal...).
2. Use objects to find the difference of this subtraction word problem:
You have 5 apples. You eat 1 apple. How many apples do you have left?
3. Use your writing cookie sheet and write your numbers to 12.
4. Stomp and count to 40.
5. Read these BIG numbers: 83, 57, 24, 96

Please ask an adult, or older brother or sister to check your answers.

Reading

1. Find an object in your house that starts with these sounds: h, d, o, m
2. Spread some flour (or any other substance that you can write in) on a baking sheet and write these vocabulary words: a, do, my, you, and
3. Find something in your house that rhymes with: pup, bug, camp
4. Blend and read these words: hot, sat, nip
5. Choose a decode book to read to someone. Don't forget to touch under each word as you read it. Then tell them what the story was about.

Math

1. Count out 15 objects (Any object will do - pennies, buttons, legos, rubber bands, noodles...).
2. Use objects to find the sum of this addition word problem. Mom has 2 pennies. Then she finds 4 more pennies. How many pennies does she have?
3. Use your writing cookie sheet and write your numbers to 17.
4. Count to 60 using a football player voice.
5. Read these BIG numbers: 71, 53, 64, 92

1. Find an object in your house that ENDS with these sounds: m, s, p, t, n
2. Spread some flour (or any other substance that you can write in) on a baking sheet and write this sentence:

3. Find something in your house that rhymes with: bone, floor, cub
4. Blend and read these words: pop, hat, mid
5. Choose a decode book to read to someone. Don't forget to touch under each word as you read it. Then tell them what the story was about.

1. Count out 17 objects (Any object will do - pennies, buttons, legos, crayons, checkers...).
2. Use objects to find the difference of this subtraction word problem.

3. Use your writing cookie sheet and write your numbers to 20.

5. Read these BIG numbers: 27, 45, 36, 88
